 SUBJECT : REVIEW OF OPERATIONS FOR THE TWELVE-MONTH
 PERIOD ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2016

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 We respectfully submit the Review of Operations for the twelve-month period ended December 31, 2016:

I. INSURANCE PRODUCTION

The total number of farmers who availed of PCIC’s various insurance lines is **1,095,024**. The premium income and area covered by crop insurance increased by **0.87%** and **5.38%** respectively from the same period last year. The total amount of insurance coverage reached **Php 39,087.814**, a decrease of 4.85% from the same period last year.

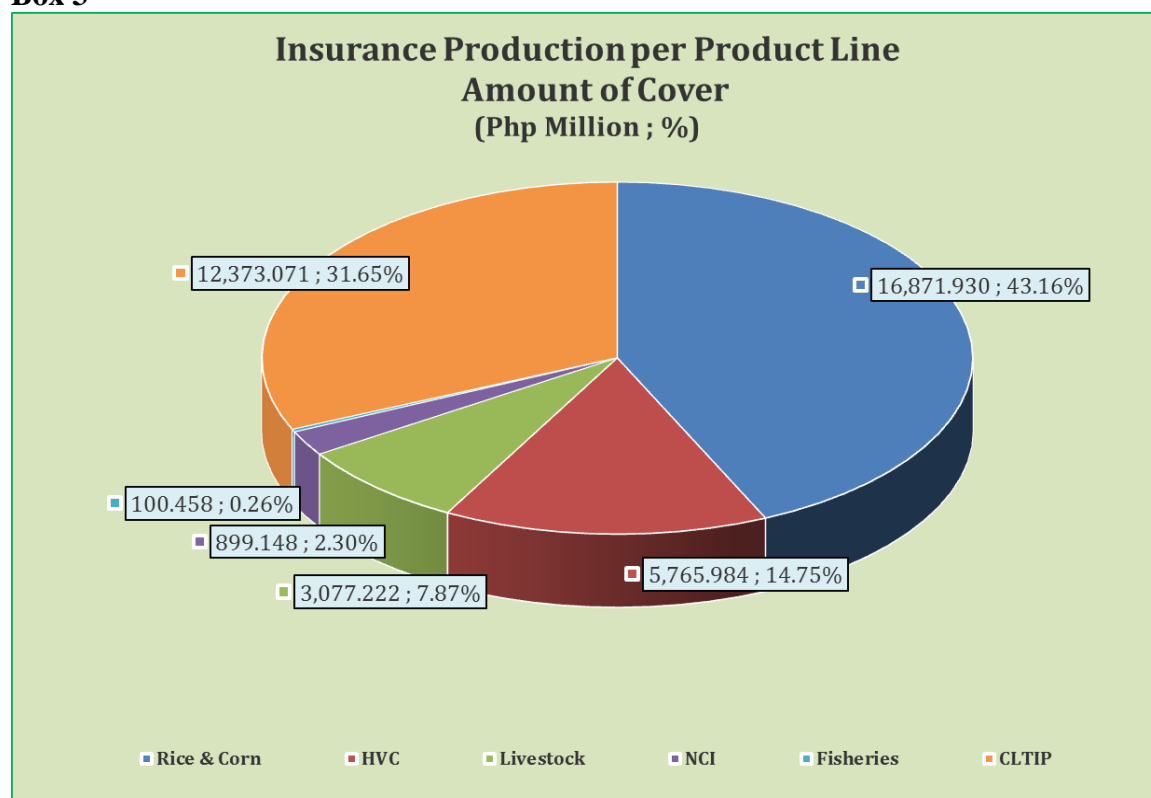

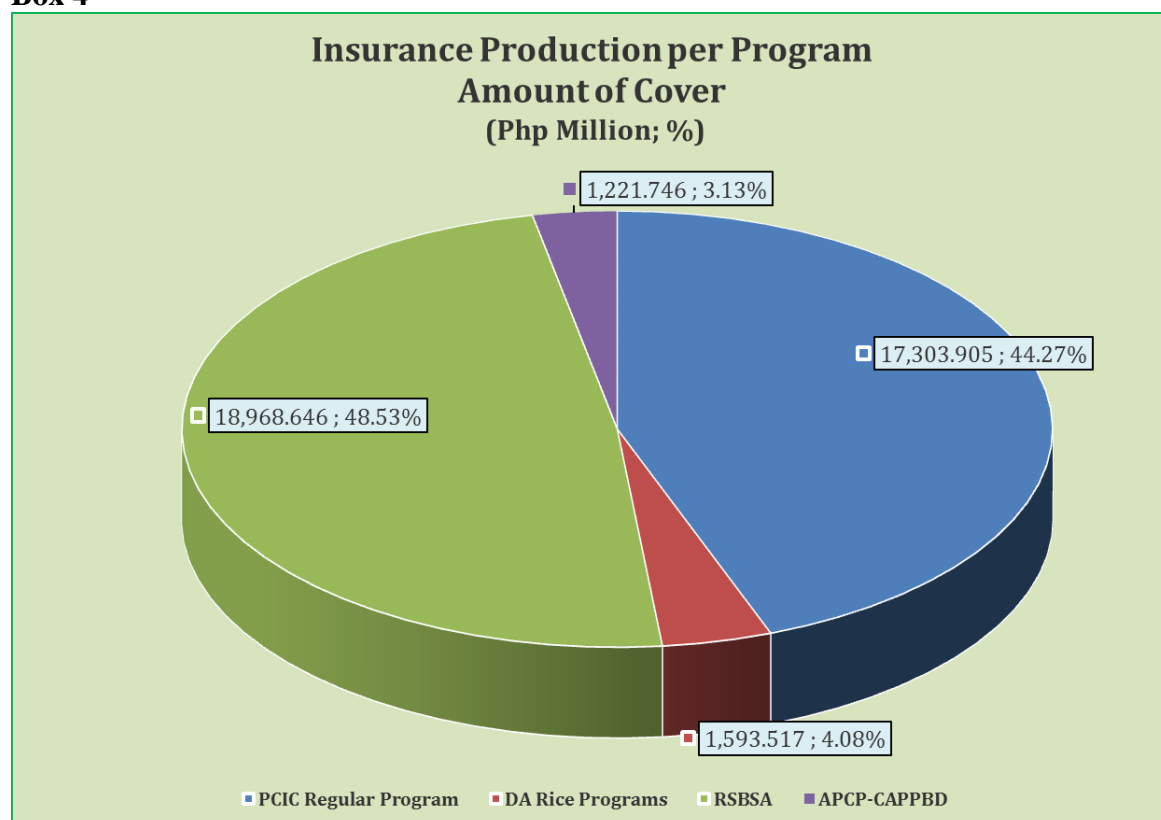

Reasons for increase of insurance production:

- Rice
 - Increasing number and continuous participation of cooperatives/farmers' organizations/associations and other lending institutions participating in LBP's rice production loan programs.
 - Insurance coverage for subsistence rice farmers listed under RSBSA with full premium subsidy under the FY 2016 GAA.
 - Continuous insurance coverage of subsistence rice farmers under the DA Rice Programs (DA-LBP Sikat Saka, WARA 2014, WARA 2015 & HYTA 2015).
 - Insurance coverage of ARBs participating in the APCP-CAPPBD program with full premium subsidy from PCIC.
 - Continuous participation in rice crop insurance of the Provincial Government of Isabela in RO II.
 - Increased number of farmers availing production loans from TSPI in ROs I, II, III, III-A, IV, V & X.
 - Increased number of farmers availing production loans from First Valley Banks in ROs IX, X & XII.

- HVC
 - Insurance coverage for subsistence farmers listed under RSBSA with full premium subsidy under the FY 2016 GAA.
 - Insurance coverage of ARBs participating in the APCP-CAPPBD program with full premium subsidy from PCIC.
 - Insurance coverage of farmers availing production loans from TSPI.

Reasons for decrease of insurance production:

- Corn
 - The farmers have failed to plant rice and corn in areas affected by continuous heavy rainfall brought by Habagat and occurrence of typhoons.
 - Termination of subsidized insurance program for Typhoon Yolanda affected areas.
- Livestock
 - Non-renewal of some insurance coverage under Provincial Government of Cebu's IFSDP
 - Termination of subsidized insurance program for Typhoon Yolanda affected areas.
- NCI
 - Non-renewal of some LIBI accounts.
 - Termination of subsidized insurance program for Typhoon Yolanda affected areas.
- CLTIP
 - Non-renewal of some NAFC members in the Accident and Dismemberment Security Scheme term insurance program.
 - Non-renewal of ADSS insurance coverage in the province of Cebu under IFSDP (RO VII).
- Fisheries
 - Non-renewal of some RSBSA farmers.

- PCIC Regular Programs

The target PCIC premium discount/subsidy for rice and corn crop insurance programs for the twelve-month period ended December 31, 2016 is Php 300 million. PCIC premium discount/subsidy utilization reached Php 208.793 million or 69.60% accomplishment.

- DA-Rice Programs

The rice crop insurance policies issued for the LBP-DA Sikat Saka, Weather Adverse Rice Areas (WARA) and High Yield Technology Adoption programs for the twelve-month period ended December 31, 2016 reached Php 1,593.517 million amount of cover and utilized Php 18.028 million DA-GPS and Php 149.058 million PCIC premium discount/subsidy.

- RSBSA Insurance Program

The target government premium subsidy (GPS) for crop, livestock, fisheries, and non-crop agricultural asset insurance programs for the twelve-month period ended December 31, 2016 is Php 1,600.000 million. PCIC utilized Php 1,905.935 million or 119.12% accomplishment for the RSBSA provinces.

- APCP and CAP-PBD Program

The insurance policies issued for the APCP and CAP-PBD Program for the twelve-month period ended December 31, 2016 reached Php 1,221.746 million amount of insurance cover and utilized Php 127.726 million PCIC discount/subsidy.

III. CLAIMS PAID

The total claims paid to farmers amounted to Php 1,510.278 million, an increase of 9.55% from the same period last year, broken down as follows.

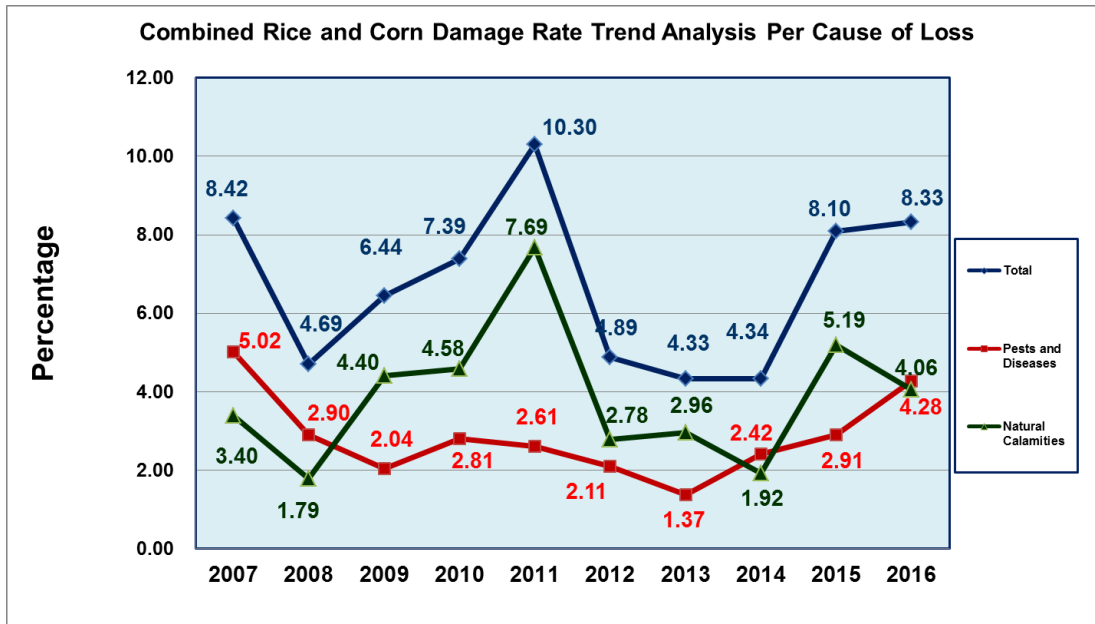

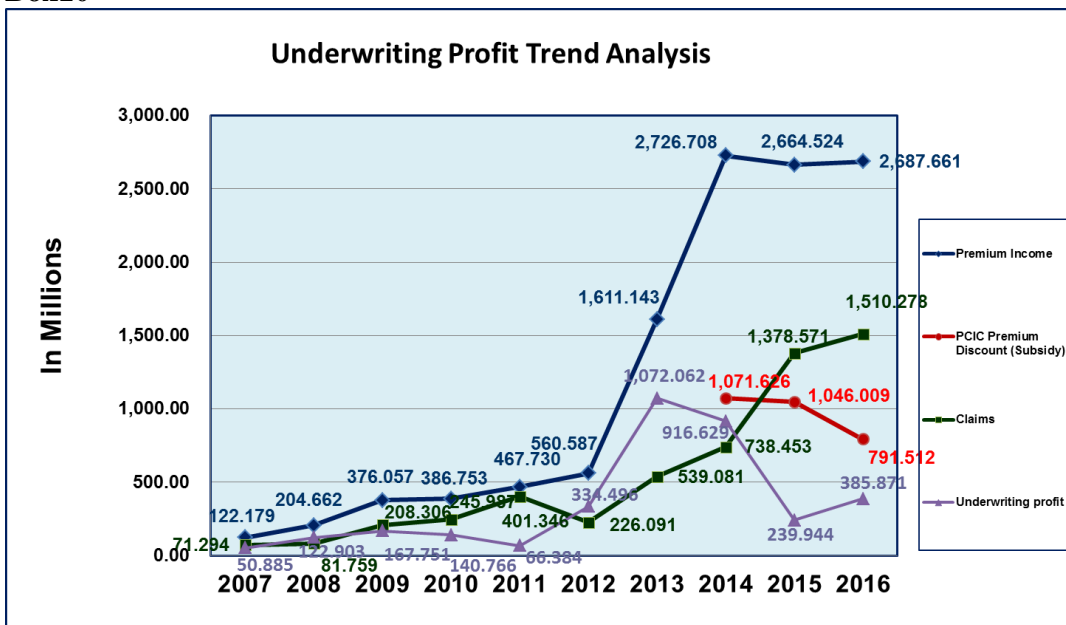
IV. STATEMENT OF UNDERWRITING PROFIT
