SUBJECT: REVIEW OF OPERATIONS FOR THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER

We respectfully submit the tentative Review of Operations for the Year Ended December 31, 2018:

I. INSURANCE PRODUCTION

The total number of farmers who availed of PCIC's various insurance lines reached **2,203,919**. The premium income and area covered by crop insurance **increased** by **43.36%** and **37.12%**, respectively, from the same period last year. The total amount of insurance coverage reached **PhP 78,163.699 million**, an **increase** of **33.69%** from the same period last year.

Figure 1. Trend Analysis of RSBSA Government Premium Subsidy (GPS) Utilization




Generally, the increased appropriation under GAA for FY 2018 for Government Premium Subsidy (GPS) to PCIC for RSBSA Agricultural Insurance Program (AIP), from PhP 2.5 billion (FY 2017) to PhP 3.5 billion (FY 2018), contributed largely in the increased production for these insurance lines: Rice, Corn, HVC, Livestock and Fisheries/Aquaculture.

The target government premium subsidy (GPS) for crop, livestock, fisheries, and non-crop agricultural asset insurance programs for the year ended December 31, 2018 is PhP 3,500.000 million. We utilized PhP 3,586.234 million or 102.46% accomplishment.

• APCP and CAP-PBD Program

The insurance policies issued for the APCP and CAP-PBD Program for the year ended December 31, 2018 reached PhP 1,063.765 million amount of insurance cover and utilized PhP 98.759 million PCIC premium subsidy.

• Non-RSBSA Program

The insurance policies issued for the Non-RSBSA Program for the year ended December 31, 2018 reached PhP 5,925.116 million amount of insurance cover and utilized PhP 503.466 million PCIC premium subsidy or 96.82% accomplishment.






IV. UNDERWRITING PROFIT
